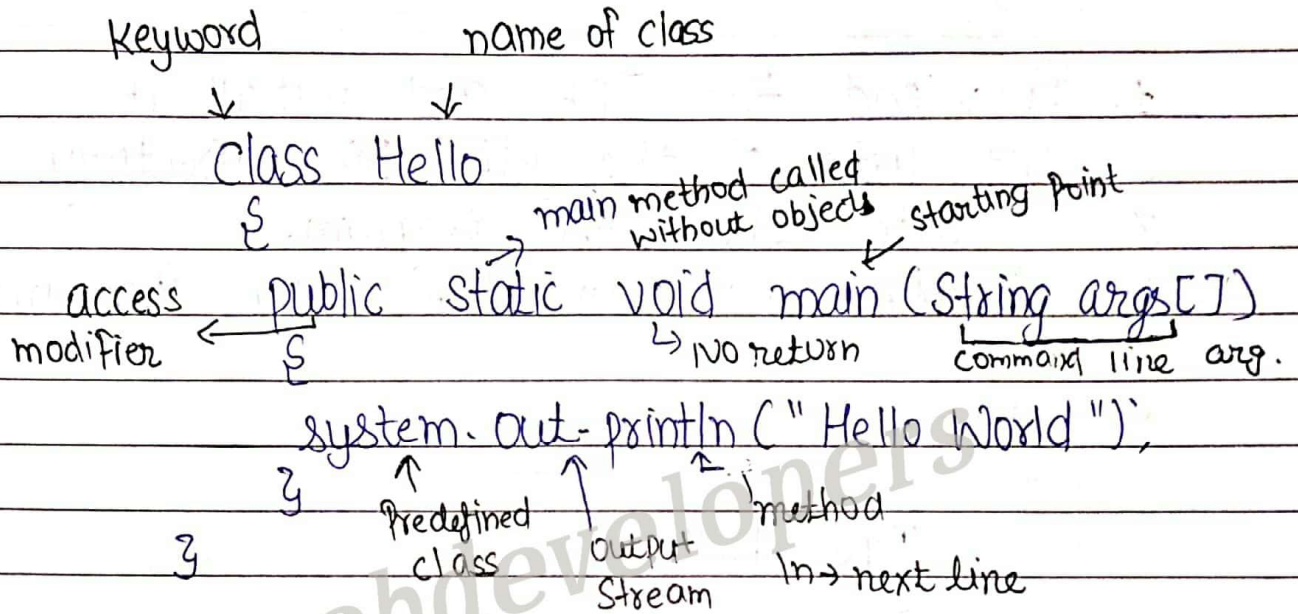


# \* How to Write First Hello world Program in Java



File Name: "Hello.java"

Output: Hello World

- **Class**:- keyword is used to declare a class in Java.
- **public**:- keyword is an access modifier.
- **static**:- is a keyword, declare method as static. There is no need to create an object to call static method.
- **void**- is the return type of method.
- **main**:- starting point of the program.
- **String args[]**:- is used for command line arg.
- **system.out.println**:- is used to print system.

## Java Hello World Program

### \* Requirement for Java "Hello World" Example

1. Download the JDK and install it.
2. Set path of the jdk / bin directory.
3. Create the Java program.
4. Compile and run the Java Program.

### \* Hello World Program

```
Class Hello
{
    public static void main (String args[])
    {
        System.out.println ("Hello World");
    }
}
```

Save the file name as :- Hello.java
